

Drop-In Tennis

Tuesdays, 7-10pm
Lake Newport Tennis Courts

How it works:

You must have your RA pass with you to participate. Bring a can of balls and your game. Doubles will be the format when people are waiting to play. Teams will play best of five games using No-Ad scoring. The winning team will stay on the same court but will split and no longer be partners. The losing team will slide to the next court down where a winning team will have split and will accept on player each. If the court next to you has not finished, you are asked to wait outside the court or on a bench. This format will continue until nobody is waiting to play. Once people are waiting to play, you are asked to go back to the five game No-Ad matches.

Courts 1 and 2 should be used by players 3.5 and below. Courts 5 and 6 should be used for 3.5 players and above when no line is present. If court 3 has no lessons at 9pm, it will be reserved for Drop-In Tennis.
